

## HPRP Assistance



To qualify for HPRP funds - ask yourself this “*Would I or my family be homeless but for this assistance?*”

### HPRP has Two Assistance Programs

1. Homelessness Prevention

Prevent individuals and families at risk of homelessness from becoming homeless

You could be eligible if:

- You are being evicted within 2 weeks
- You are being discharge from institution within 2 weeks
- Living in condemned housing
- Experienced sudden loss of income or increase in utility costs
- Have mental health and substance abuse issues
- Have physical disabilities and chronic health issues
- Have extremely low income ( $\leq 30\%$  AMI)
- Incurred significant medical debt

2. Rapid Re-Housing

Assist persons experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized

Individuals and families are homeless if they are:

- Sleeping in emergency shelter
- Sleeping in place not meant for human habitation
- Staying in hospital or institution for up to 180 days, but literally homeless immediately prior to entry
- Graduating from/timing out of transitional housing
- Victim of domestic violence
