

The Senior Chores & More Program

provides chore and homemaker services to seniors 60 years of age and older living in Anoka County.



Helpful Services

Chores

We provide washing windows and walls, completing basic home maintenance (excludes rental property), yard work (mowing, trimming of shrubs, raking or snow removal).

Housekeeping

We provide light housekeeping (laundry, vacuuming, sweeping floors, cleaning the bathroom or kitchen).

(All services are based upon the availability of volunteers and workers in the client's area)

What to Expect

- Courteous service from office staff, contract workers and volunteers
- Services provided upon availability of workers
- A suggested donation/sliding fee scale for eligible clients
- Labor provided by the program and worker, materials provided by the client (unless other arrangements have been made)

Who performs these services?

Paid independent contractors are encouraged to work with us.

- Contractors are reimbursed for their time according to the current pay scale.
- Background checks are performed on contractors and individual volunteers.
- They are interviewed and sign off on agreements with our program guidelines.
- Contractors contact clients to schedule requested services.
